

Rural Municipality of Meadow Lake #588

Bylaw #6/14

A BYLAW TO RESTRICT THE WEIGHT OF VEHICLES USING BRIDGES

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Meadow Lake #588, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. In the bylaw the expression:
 - a. "Motor Vehicles" shall have the same meaning ascribed to it by The Vehicles Weights and Dimension Regulations.
 - b. "municipality" shall mean the RM of Meadow Lake #588
2. It shall be unlawful to drive any motor vehicle with a gross weight of more than 22.5 (twenty-two and one half) tonnes over the bridge located North of NE-35-57-14-W3.
3. As follows:
 - a. Any person who contravenes the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalties imposed in the general penalty bylaw of the municipality.
 - b. Pursuant to the Highways and Transportation Act, where such person is convicted, the convicting provincial magistrate or justice of the peace may, if the public improvement injured is a public highway or anything forming part of or used in connection with such highway, order the person to pay to the municipality the cost of repairing the injury, and if the person fails to comply with the order, the cost of the repairing the injury may be recovered from the person or owner as the debt due to the municipality.
4. Bylaw #2/95 and #14/06 are hereby repealed.
