

Bylaw to Repeal Designation
As Municipal Heritage Property
The Heritage Property Act S.S. 1979-80, c.H-2.2 s.18

Bylaw #21/14

A Bylaw of the Rural Municipality of Meadow Lake #588 to repeal the designation of a site as Municipal Heritage Property.

WHEREAS Sections 11 and 12 of *The Heritage Property Act* authorizes the Council of a Municipality to enact bylaws to designate real property, including all buildings, features and structures thereon, to be of heritage value; and,

WHEREAS the Council of the Municipality has previously designated the property known as:
CABANA COMMUNITY HALL

And located at:

NE-01-59-16-W3 in the Province of Saskatchewan

As Municipal Heritage Property by Bylaw No. 33 read a third time and passed by the Council of the Municipality on the 13th day of June, 1983; and

WHEREAS Sections 17 and 18 of *The Heritage Property Act* authorize the Council of a municipality to enact bylaws to repeal designation of real property; and,

WHEREAS the Council of the Municipality has caused, not less than thirty (30) days prior to consideration of this bylaw, a Notice of Intention to Repeal to be:

- a. Served on the owners of said property;
- b. Served on the Registrar of Heritage Property; and,
- c. Published in one issue of a newspaper with general circulation in the municipality; and,

WHEREAS no Notice of Objection to the proposed repeal of designation has been served on the Council of the Municipality;

THEREFORE, the Council of the Municipality enacts as follows:

1. Repeal Bylaw No. 33, enacted on the 13th day of June, 1983 to designate as Municipal Heritage Property the real property legally described as NE-01-59-16-W3
The reasons for the repeal being as follows:
 - a. Property is not being used as a public hall anymore;
 - b. No one is willing to take responsibility for the property;
 - c. The property has fallen into a state of disrepair and is a target for vandalism.
2. The Municipal Administrator is hereby authorized to:
 - a. Discharge any interest based on the notice of designation that was registered in the Land Titles Registry; and,
 - b. Notify all property owners of the repeal.
3. The Municipal Administrator is hereby authorized to cause a certified copy of this bylaw to be served on the Registrar of Heritage Property.
