Policy Title: Burning Permits

Policy Objective: To set regulations for the purpose of issuing of burning permits	
Authority: Council Resolution #248/16	Dated: July 11, 2016

Policy:

1. To set regulations in order to maintain a controlled fire burning within the RM of Meadow Lake.
2. Permits are required due to the numerous calls to 911 Service from individual who see a fire or smoke. In these instances, the fire department, Sask. Environment and other Emergency responders will action the call. However, if a burn permit is issued, the 911 Service is aware of the “controlled burn” and will be able to have knowledge and give the correct information to the Emergency responding units.
3. All permits issued in the 4.5 km (3 mile) area around the Provincial Forest must include the Saskatchewan Environmental Authorization number as issued by Sask. Environment office.

Burning Permits are issued as follows:

1. Permits are free of charge
2. Permits will only be given out if there are no fire bans in the area
3. Permits are required 12 month of the year
