Policy Title: Liquor Permit Policy


Policy Objective: To give authorization for residents to acquire Liquor Permits from the Sask. Liquor and Gaming	
Authority: Council Resolution #269/16	Dated: August 8, 2016

Background:

1. Under the Saskatchewan Liquor and Gaming regulations, any persons applying for a license to sell liquor at their establishments, homes, yards, or functions thereon.
2. Anyone holding a function involved in the sale of alcohol must have the land location, date, time, and type of function.
3. The Municipality in which the property is situated must give their approval to hold such function.

Policy:

1. The Council for the RM of Meadow Lake #588 authorize the Administrator to provide a letter of approval for any function within the RM of Meadow Lake #588 boundaries with the following stipulations;
 - a. That a letter of request must be completed by the applicant stating
 - i. Date and time of bar hours
 - ii. Name
 - iii. Location
 - b. That approval will be given by the Administrator on behalf of the Council; and
 - c. That the "RM of Meadow Lake does not accept any responsibility for any problem, accident or liability that may arise from the function".
