



# Rural Municipality of Meadow Lake #588 Policy

Policy Title: Fencing

<b>Policy Objective:</b> To establish a policy for the purpose of fencing	
<b>Authority:</b> Council Resolution #339/15	Dated: November 10, 2015

**Background:**

1. The RM of Meadow Lake #588 has a workforce to help with the construction of municipal roads.
2. All ratepayers completing their fencing process' differently and it is difficult to complete the fencing techniques to each individual ratepayers needs

**Policy:**

1. If no fence is existing, there will be NO reimbursement, payout, or placement of a fence while the municipality is constructing or re-constructing a municipal road.
2. Existing Fences
  - a. If the RM requires to have a fence removed due to road construction
    - i. Removal and replacement of fence shall be completed by the landowner; and
    - ii. The RM will pay \$3,500.00 per mile and the landowner will supply all posts, wire and labour;
    - iii. All fences must be placed at the edge of the right of way (minimum 100 foot right of way)
    - iv. Temporary fencing is at the cost of the landowners;
    - v. Any brushing or clearing for the fence line will be at the cost of the landowner.

**\*\*NOTE:** A fence must be placed on the landowner property when the fence is originally placed. Most fences should have been placed at a minimum of the 66 foot right of way, unless otherwise stated.

If the municipality is requiring to increase the right of way to the 100 foot right of way, reimbursement will be made to the landowner for the price of the land as per Policy #TS-010.

Council retains the right of discretion should any other payments be required for the brushing or clearing.
