

# HIGHWAY 26

## Thin Membrane Surface Upgrade: Near Goodsoil and Loon Lake



### PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Ministry of Highways plans to build a new surfacing structure on Highway 26 near Loon Lake and near Goodsoil. This project is part of the Government of Saskatchewan's 2020-2021 investment in improving safety and efficiency on key highway corridors.

The estimated cost of this project is \$20.3 million.

**Project start: August 2021**

**Project specified completion date: October 1, 2022**



### TRAFFIC IMPACT

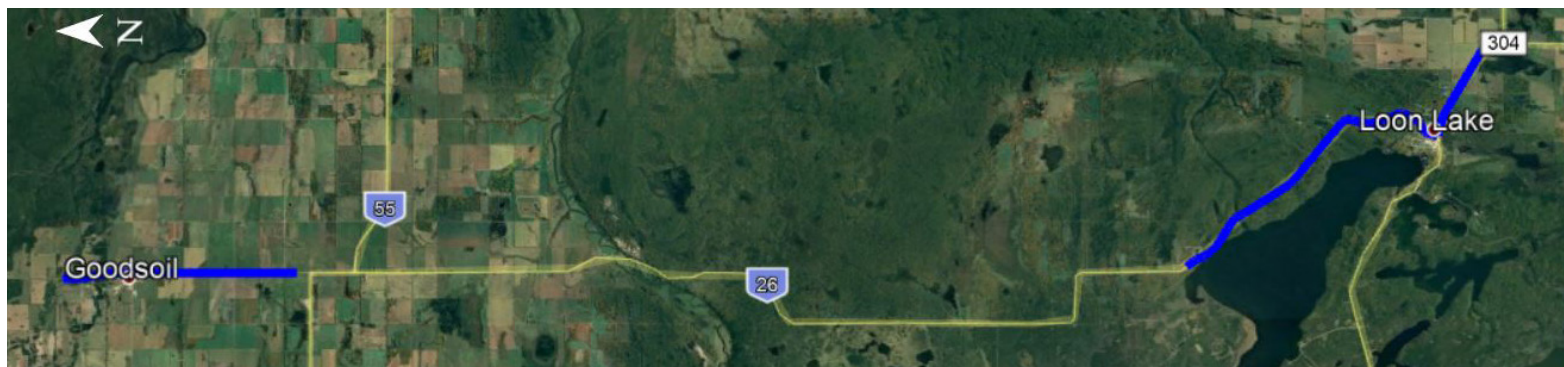
You can expect minor delays and disruptions along Highway 26. Traffic through the work zone will be one-way and will be at a reduced speed of 60 kmh.
