




BYLAW #7/06


A BYLAW TO LICENSE MINING CONTRACTORS AND WELL-DRILLING CONTRACTORS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Meadow Lake #588, in the Province of Saskatchewan, pursuant to Section 9(b) of the Municipal Act, enacts as follows:

1. For the purpose of this bylaw, the word "contractor" shall include any person, firm or corporation.
2. Every well-drilling contractor who is not assessable for the purpose of a tax levy in the municipality, shall, before undertaking well-drilling in the municipality, pay to the municipality the following license fees:
 - a. For the drilling of an oil well or a gas well - **\$450.00**
 - b. For the drilling of a hole, other than a hole drilled for seismic testing, to a point below the drift for the purpose of obtaining geological and structural information - **\$225.00.**
 - c. Domestic Water Well drilling will be exempt.
3. Any contractor holding a license under this bylaw shall produce and exhibit his license when required to do so by the RM of Meadow Lake #588 designated personnel.
4. Bylaw #2/91 is hereby Repealed.
